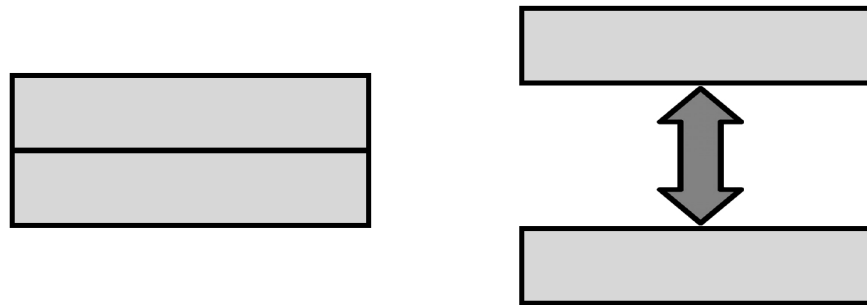

SPLIT TABLE is a simple table for dining, working or display that achieves balanced goals of beauty and utility.

The table is at once one table and two, adaptable to a variety of spaces and conditions. Together, the two sections provide an generous size for a dining table; apart, they become sideboards, counters or simply stored away.

Ideal for compact living spaces or adaptable environments, the table can easily transform on a daily or occasional basis.

The table's legs are angled to provide stability for the long, narrow structure and to accomodate seating at both the long and short ends.



CONCEPTUAL DESCRIPTION

SPLIT TABLE

SPLIT TABLE is an assembly of parts as simple and elegant as its use.

Two slabs of African Mahogany comprise the table tops.

Four legs of flat bronze bars create the table legs. The legs are square-shaped and are cut into the tops, forming two square voids when assembled.

Simple thumb turn mechanisms at the underside of the tops lock the tables together when assembled.

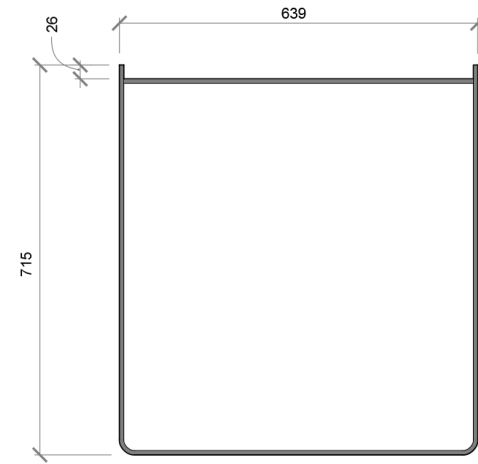
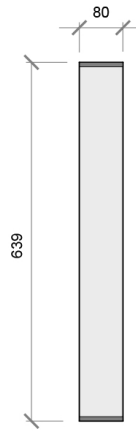
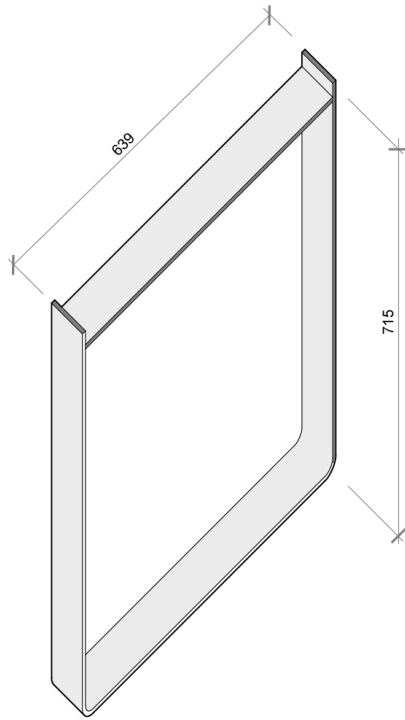

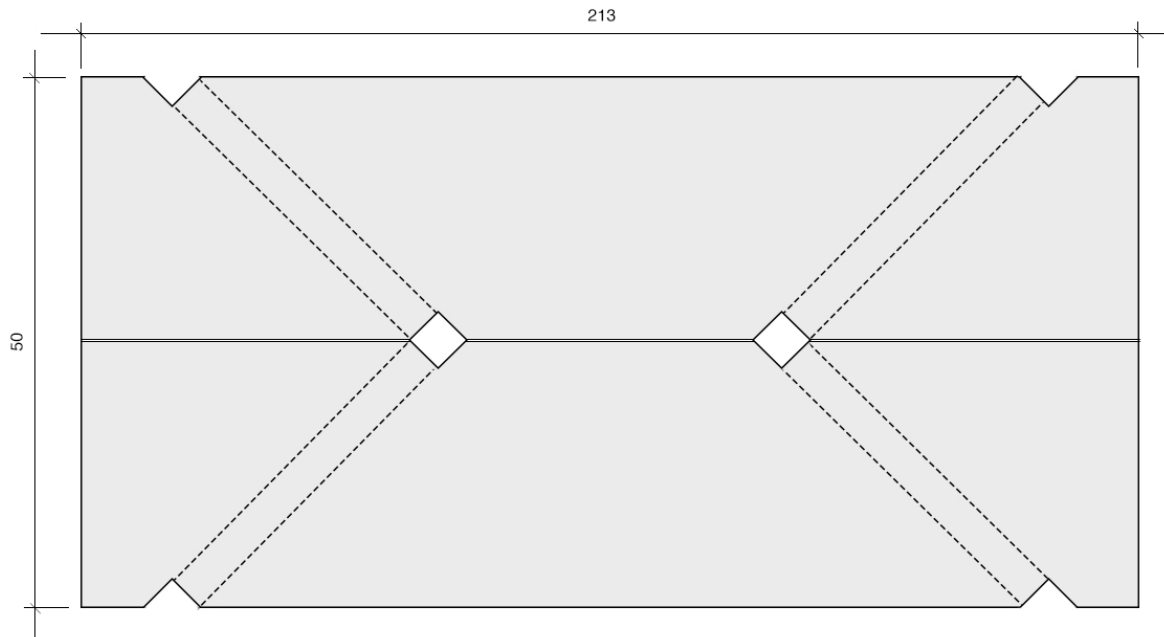


TABLE TOP DETAILS

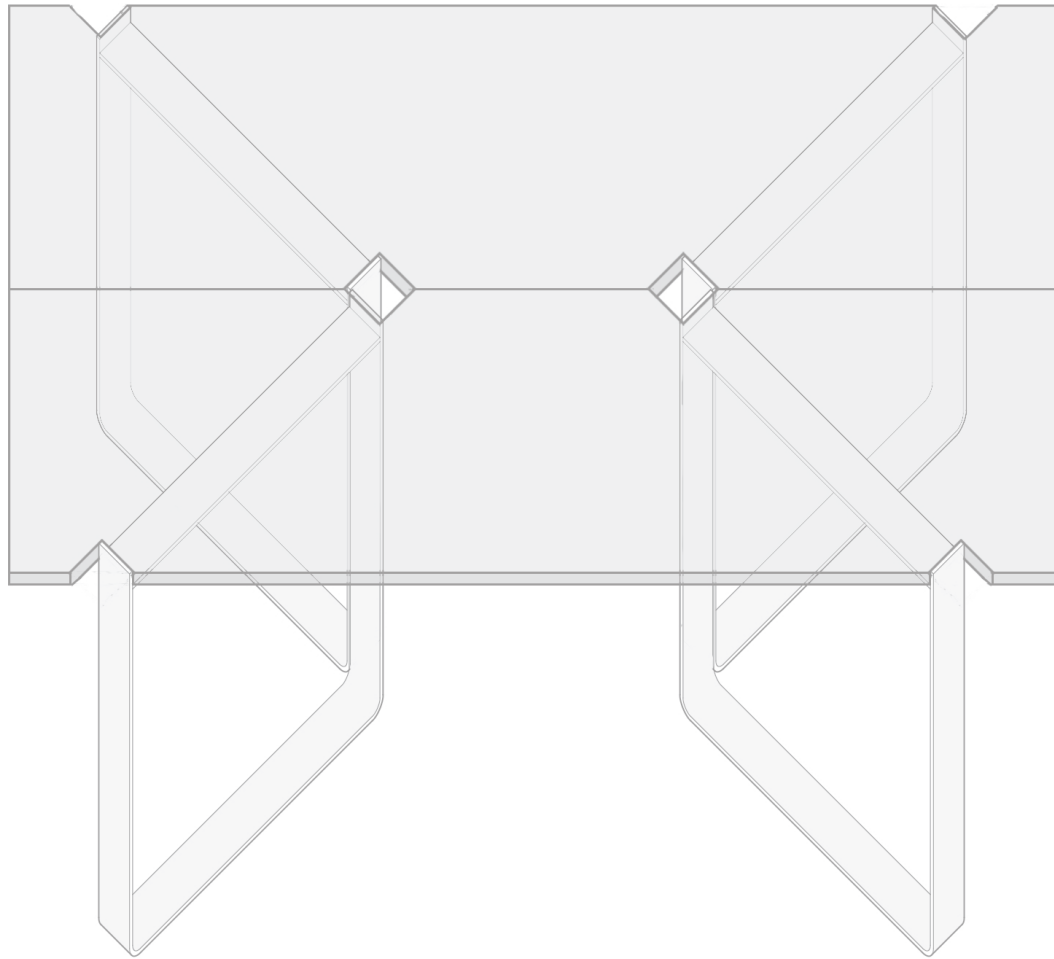


TABLE AXONOMETRIC VIEW

SPLIT TABLE

SPLIT TABLE consists of two materials: solid African Mahogany wood planks for the top and brushed brass plate for the legs. The wood is simply planed, sanded and finished with a gloss laquer. The brass is bent, welded and affixed to the tops. A series of brass clasp locks are affixed to the bottom of the wood tops.
